1. IN CONSIDERATION of being permitted to participate in any way in USA Table Tennis sanctioned events, I and/or minor child, our personal representatives, assigns, heirs, and next of kin:
2. ACKNOWLEDGE, agree, and represent that I and/or minor child understand the nature of Table Tennis Activities and that I and/or minor child are qualified, in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in such Activity. I further agree that if at any time I believe conditions or equipment to be unsafe, I and/or minor child will immediately discontinue further participation in the Activity.
3. FULLY UNDERSTAND that (a) TABLE TENNIS ACTIVITIES INVOLVE RISKS AND DANGERS OF SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING PERMANENT DISABILITY, PARALYSIS AND DEATH, HARASSMENT, EXPOSURE TO INAPPROPRIATE CONDUCT AND LANGUAGE ("RISKS"); (b) these Risks and dangers may be caused by me and/or minor child's own actions, or inaction, or the actions or inaction of others participating in the Activity, the condition in which the Activity takes place, or THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" NAMED BELOW; (c) there may be OTHER RISKS AND SEVERE SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC LOSSES either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I FULLY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS AND ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSSES, COSTS, AND DAMAGES I and/or minor child incur as a result of my participation in the Activity.

Deadline:

Entry Deadline for the 2010 USA Table Tennis Nationals is Thursday, October 21, 2010. Late entries postmarked after October 21 require a \$75 late fee. Entries postmarked after October 30, 2010 WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

Eligibility:

Entries are limited to active USATT members as follows:

National Championships Events: Events 1-33 – U.S. Citizens-Proof of Citizenship must be submitted with the entry form.

"Mr. Neng-Chin Shih Memorial" Cadet and Junior National Championships Events (Events 6 -9)

*Cadet Boys'/Girls' - Born on or after January 1, 1996

*Junior Boys'/Girls' – Born on or after January 1, 1993

Minicadet National Championships Events (Events 10 and 11)
Minicadet Boys'/Girls' – Born on or after January 1, 1997

Championship Hard Bat and Rating Events (Events 34-60)

For All Above Events Please contact USATT Headquarters (719-866-4583) regarding eligibility questions

Membership:

USATT Memberships must be valid through December 31, 2010. Non-members or expired memberships must enclose membership fee with their entry forms.

Rules:

The 2010 USA Table Tennis Nationals will be conducted under the Laws of Table Tennis. Specifically, 3.53 Good Presentation supplement in the The Laws of Table Tennis. All decisions by the Tournament Committee will be final and contestants upon entering agree to abide by them.

Equipment:

Tables and nets: Butterfly. Balls: Nittaku orange 3-star 40mm. Floor: Two surfaces – red rubberized floor and concrete. This is the *Official Approved Equipment* for the 2010 USA Table Tennis National Championships. **"Rackets in all events are subject to random testing for volatile organic compounds(VOC's). Any glues containing VOC's will cause the racket to fail."**

Clothing:

The USATT Dress Code will be enforced. Players **must** wear the assigned player numbers when competing.

Entries:

Players may enter a maximum of 8 events but may not enter two events starting at the same time. RATING EVENTS:

Players may enter a maximum of 5 rating events. Events chosen must be within the 5 sequential order that are above his/her rating used for the 2010 USATT Nationals. For example, if a player's rating is 1346, he/she may participate in any or all of the following: U1400, U1500, U1600, U1700 and U1800. However, he/she may NOT participate in the U1400, U1500, U1600, **AND** U1900 and U2000 events since these are not in sequential order. Players that are over the rating limit of an event will automatically be entered in the next higher rating event.

RATING DOUBLES EVENTS: Players may enter only one rating doubles event. Players **MUST** be rated under 2500 to participate in the U4200 Doubles, under 2250 to participate in the U3700 Doubles, under 2000 to participate in U3200 Doubles and under 1600 to participate in U2700 Doubles.

Doubles Partners:

Players **MUST** enter with a partner in all doubles events. **USA Table Tennis will NOT arrange for a doubles partner.** USATT can not be responsible for the non-participation of your selected Doubles Partner. It is the responsibility of the players to contact his/her doubles partner about participating in the event. No refund will be given for an event if a partner is not available. **Special Note:** No change in doubles partners, addition or deletion of events or refund of event fees will be allowed after the final deadline or at the tournament.

Age Restrictions:

Players assume the responsibility of entering the appropriate age events. Players who are over/under the age limit of an event will automatically be entered in the correct age event.

Rating Restrictions and Seeding:

For rating eligibility, the ratings list as of 10/1/2010 will be used. This can be found at www.usatt.org/events/2010nationals/ratings. For draw and seeding purposes, the most recent USATT ratings list as of 11/26/2010 will be used. Players assume the responsibility of entering the proper events. Player that are over the rating limit of an event will automatically be entered in the next event. Players may obtain their ratings by contacting USA Table Tennis via email at admin@usatt.org. As a result of later seeding, some players may have ratings higher than shown for the event.

Unrated Players: (players without USATT rating):

Unrated players may enter any championship event for which they are otherwise eligible. Unrated players will not advance in the rating-limited events, with the exception of the *Unrated RR*. Unrated players may not enter ratings doubles events.

Matches:

All matches at the 2010 USA Table Tennis Championships will utilize 11-point game rules with the exception of hard bat events (see hard bat info). Men's and Women's Championship events will be best of seven (11-point games) from the round of 32. All RR events will be the best of five (11-point games). All other events will be the best of five (11-point games), single elimination, unless otherwise indicated.

Event Scheduling:

Events are not guaranteed to be completed on the same day that they begin. No refunds will be given for early departure. All events will be completed by Saturday evening. The Men's and Women's Singles semi-finals and finals are tentatively scheduled for Saturday, December 18.

Any event may be cancelled and the entry fee for that one event refunded if the event contains less than four players or pairs, as appropriate. In the case of event conflicts, the player is responsible for notifying the Control Desk as soon as possible. In case of an inadvertent error, liability is limited to the refund of the event fee for the event(s) involved.

Championship Age Events:

Players must be over 30, 40, 50, 60, 70, 75, and 80 as of December 31, 2010. Players for U-10 Boys and Girls must be born on or after January 1, 2000. Players in the 21&U Men's and Women's Singles must be born on or after January 1, 1989. **Proof of age must be readily available at the tournament.**

Withdrawal/Refunds:

A \$45 processing fee will be charged to any participant who withdraws from the tournament prior to November 11, 2010. **There will be no refunds after this date.** Withdrawal notification must be **in writing** at USATT Headquarters in order to receive a refund. **There will be no refunds given at the tournament.**

PLAYING FORMATS:

Junior and Cadet National Championship Events:

The Playing format for these events will be based on number of entries. First stage – Round Robin groups and Second stage – Single elimination. All matches will be played best of five games

Minicadet National Championship Events:

Top 4 finishers in these events will qualify as members of the 2010 USA Minicadet National Team and will be considered for international Events based on USATT budget availability and invitations received.

The Playing format for these events will be based on number of entries. First stage – Round Robin groups and Second stage – Single elimination. All matches will be played best of five games

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Junior Boys and Girls Teams:

The USA club must send an email to admin@usatt.org with Club Name along with Names of the Team Players. The Junior Teams will not be accepted without Club approval. The Club along with the Names of the Team Mates must be listed on the entry form. Playing system: Corbillon Cup System: 4 singles and 1 doubles. A-X, B-Y. Doubles, A-Y, B-X. Playing system will be Single or Round Robin depending on number of entries.

Men's and Women's Singles Championship Events:

In the men's singles, the top 16 players will be seeded into the main draw of 64 players. In women's singles, the top 8 players will be seeded into the main draw of 32 players. Depending on the number of entries, all other players will be drawn into qualification RR groups to advance into the main draw. The main draw will be played in a singles elimination format. All matches from the round of 32 will be played best of seven games. All other matches will be played best of five games.

LIHA Sandpaper:

The same rules as Hardbat(see below) will apply except the equipment shall be an all-wood blade with a sandpaper only cover of the playing surface and 38mm balls.

Hard Bat Events:

Hard Bat rules, as adopted by the USATT Hard Bat Committee, will be used for all hard bat events. See www.hardbat.com for the complete list of official rules. As in all events, a question of racquet legality is the decision of the Tournament Referee. Rackets complying with all requirements of the rules for Hard Bat rackets shall be legal. These events do not count for USATT ratings points. Eligibility for the hard bat rating events will be determined by the player's USATT rating. However, draws for the hard bat events will be conducted on the basis of the ratings maintained by the Hard Bat Committee. If the participant enters the U-2000 Hard Bat RR, U-1800 Hard Bat RR, or U-1500 Hard Bat RR and there are insufficient entries, he/she will automatically be moved into the U-2000 RR, U-1800 RR, or U-1500 RR, if eligible. All hard bat matches will be played to 21-point games. All matches will be the best of 3 games, except for Hard Bat singles, where the quarterfinals, semifinals, and final will be best of 5 games.

Registration:

Display and/or distribution of any brochures, posters, literature, or written material at the tournament venue is strictly prohibited unless previously approved by USA Table Tennis.

Additional tickets may be purchased on this entry form.
